

Middleburg American Legion Post 250 Recommended Disaster Prep Kits



As we get ready for Hurricane Season, the following items are suggested to be in your Disaster Preparation Kits

- One gallon of water per person per day (minimum of 3 days)
- 3-days supply of non-perishable food
- Battery powered or hand crank radio (preferably with NOAA weather bands) and extra batteries
- Flashlights and extra batteries
- First-aid kit
- Cell phones with chargers and inverter for vehicle or solar charging panel
- Whistle (to signal for help)
- Dust masks to help filter contaminated air
- Plastic sheeting (or tarps) and duct tape to shelter in place
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for sanitation
- Wrench and/or pliers to help turn off utilizes (if needed)
- Can opener for food
- Local maps
- Prescription medications and glasses
- Sleeping bags or warm blankets for each person
- Infant formula (if needed)
- Pet food and extra water for pets
- Important family documents (in waterproof container)
 - Insurance policies
 - o Bank account numbers
 - **o Birth Certificates**
 - o SSN Cards
 - Copies of Driver's License / IDs
- Cash or traveler's checks



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- Complete change of clothes
 - o Long Pants
 - Long Sleeve Shirts
 - o Underwear
 - o Sock
 - Sturdy Shoes
- Household cleaners
 - Bleach (Can be used with medicine dropper to treat water by using 16 drops of bleach to a gallon of water – DO NOT use scented or colored bleaches or bleaches with added cleaners)
 - General Cleaners
 - o Broom
 - o Mop
 - o Sponges
 - o Rags
- Fire extinguishers
- Matches (preferably waterproof or in waterproof container)
- Feminine supplies / personal hygiene supplies
- Mess kits
 - Plates
 - o Cups
 - o Plastic Utensils
- Paper and Pencil (or Pen)
- Entertainment items
 - o Books
 - Games
 - o Puzzles

Disaster Kits are available commercially from many sources, but make sure you customize YOUR kit to YOUR needs!
